

Pathway Mapping Project Website Now Available!

As a key element of Guided Pathways within Transformation, the Pathway Mapping Project Team has the specific charge to create clear, coherent, and shared degree pathways for our students across our colleges. The goal is to map at least 200 programs and have them ready for delivery to students in SIS by 2020 Fall priority registration. Since May 2018, 30 programs have been mapped representing maps for 91 awards, and over 300 faculty and staff have been engaged in cross-college pathway mapping teams. Another 31 programs are scheduled to be mapped and will be completed by the end of the Fall 2018 semester.

The Pathway Mapping Project Team has developed a [Guided Pathways Mapping Project site](#) that provides a description of the pathway mapping process, project progress updates, and the mapping workshop schedules for Fall 2018, Spring 2019, and Summer 2019.
